High Pastures was originally built as a mansion in 1922. It was converted into a nursing home in the 1970's. Today, the home itself has been maintained to exceedingly high standards and still retains the grandeur of the original country house. The home stands in an acre of mature, well kept gardens. Built upon the highest point in Deganwy, it commands magnificent views across the Conwy Estuary, Conwy Castle and the Snowdonia Mountain range as far as Betws-Y-Coed. High Pastures is registered with Care Inspectorate Wales as a general nursing home, providing permanent nursing care. We are a family-run business; The directors include Dr Zahid Chohan, a local GP with over 30 years' experience within health care, and Sarah Zahid whom holds extensive qualifications in the field of medicine and public health.

We are split upon two floors and cater for up to 44 residents, providing 43 single rooms and one double room (32 with en-suite facilities). A fully serviced passenger lift is available for wheelchair access. All rooms are connected to a Nurse Call System. Residents are encouraged to bring their personal possessions with them to facilitate a homely environment. The Home is centrally heated and is fully protected by a comprehensive fire detection system. All bathrooms are equipped with specialist lifting equipment for safe, assisted bathing.


We have an in-house hairdresser and weekly chiropodist visits. Residents have the opportunity to order their favourite newspapers to the Home upon request

Fresh home cooking is offered to residents at High Pastures and special dietary needs and personal preferences are catered for.

High Pastures and our catering department have been awarded a 5- star rating for good quality food and hygiene by the department of environmental health. This achievement in food preparation and nutrition is paramount in our residents' care and well-being. Our chefs prepare three freshly cooked meals a day, using local produce where possible. Menus are varied and are cooked to suit individual allergies, likes and dislikes.
